


PROPANE - Weed Burner with Piezo Auto Ignition



TO ASSEMBLE

- 1. Ensure the flame control knob is turned off fully clockwise.
- Keep the cylinder in an upright position and place the torch valve on top of the cylinder BOM fitting (CGA600).
- Gently screw (clockwise) the valve onto the cylinder.
 CAUTION DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN

TO IGNITE

- To avoid injury or damage always point the burner away from your body and any flammable or combustible materials.
- Turn the flame control knob on anti-clockwise.
- 3. Press the piezo auto ignition button to ignite the burner.

ADJUSTING THE FLAME LEVEL.

Turn the flame control knob anti-clockwise to increase the flame (+).

Turn the flame control knob clockwise to decrease the flame (-).

TO EXTINGUISH

Turn the flame control off (-) fully clockwise.

TO DISASSEMBLE

- 1. Follow the EXTINGUISH instructions.
- 2. Ensure burner has cooled properly.
- Gently screw (anti-clockwise) the weed burner from the gas cylinder.
- 4. Replace the gas cylinder cap to keep the valve clean.

STORAGE

Flame Control Knob

- Always detach torch from cylinder when not in use.
- Make sure that the cylinder is disconnected and is stored in a
 well ventilated area, out of the reach of children, free from direct
 sunlight, heat and ignition sources. If being stored indoors,
 ensure that the location complies with the standard AS/NZS
 1506
- Do not store chemicals or flammable materials, or spray aerosols near this appliance.

MAINTENANCE/SERVICING

If symptoms such as flaring burner, issues with lighting, leaks from seals or problems with gas control are identified, do not attempt to repair, return to your authorised stockist for service and maintenance.

This appliance must only be serviced by an authorised person.

HOW TO USE THE TRADEFLAME WEED BURNER

Holding the burner about 5 cm above the weeds, slowly heat the weed until it goes darker green. The weed should be heated only and not burnt. The heating causes the cell walls in the plant to burst and the plant wilts naturally. The effect can be checked by pressing a leaf of the weed between the fingertips - a dark green fingerprint will appear on the leaf when heated correctly.

After 3-5 days the weeds should have dried out completely - with just the need to clean up and compost. The weed burner is best used in spring and is most effective against smaller weeds, so it is best to get to them while they are still small and just starting to grow. Small weeds die completely after one treatment. Grass, dandelion and other perennial weeds need repeated treatment throughout the growing season.

Extreme caution must be used when working around dry grass and leaves. Fires can start very easily and spread very quickly. This product is not intended to light the weeds on fire, it is intended to only singe the weeds so they wilt and die. Keep a hose or water handy when using this product.
