


# **MICRO JET BUTANE TORCH**

# **PRODUCT MANUAL**

TORCH IS SUPPLIED WITHOUT GAS. TORCH REQUIRES FILLING BEFORE USE. USE WITH TRADEFLAME BUTANE GAS REFILL 70G (10000602 / 326602) & 200G (10000603 / 326603)

**CAUTION:** For maximum protection, always wear safety goggles, gloves or other appropriate equipment

IMPORTANT: READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE CAREFULLY. FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE APPLIANCE BEFORE CONNECTING IT TO ITS GAS CONTAINER. KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

#### **FEATURES**

- Gas: Suitable for use with Butane (sold separately)
- Effortless ignition: Ditch the matches! A simple trigger click sparks the flame instantly
- Compact powerhouse: Lightweight and portable, this torch goes wherever your projects take you

## **TO IGNITE**

- 1. Unlock safety cap by pressing the unlock button.
- 2. While gently pressing the unlock button, slowly depress the ignition button.

# **TO EXTINGUISH**

- 1. Release the ignition button. Torch will shut off immediately.
- 2. Close the flame nozzle cover.

# **FILLING / REFILLING GAS**

- 1. Ensure safety cap is in place.
- 2. Shake gas cartridge well.
- Insert cartridge nozzle vertically into gas refill valve at the bas of the Micro Jet Butane Torch. Press firmly to start gas flow. DO NOT OVERFILL.
- 4. Refill in a well-ventilated area and away from fire or ignition sources.
- **5.** Allow 2 3 seconds to refill torch.
- 6. Before igniting, allow 90 seconds for gas to stabilise.

#### WARNING

### **SAFETY INFORMATION**

- Inspect the appliance regularly for signs of wear, leaks or incorrect operation.
- Do not modify this appliance.
- · Ensure all packaging is removed prior to use.
- · Check that seals are in place and in good condition.
- Do not use this appliance if it has damaged or worn seals.
- Do not use the appliance if it is leaking, damaged or does not operate properly.
- Refill in a well-ventilated location, preferably outside, away from people and any source of ignition, such as naked flames, pilot flame, electric heaters/equipment.
- To avoid injury or damage, only ignite the torch when clear of face, hands, clothing or combustible materials.
- Always inspect your environment before igniting to ensure the area is clear of any
  potential ignition sources or hazards.
- The burner becomes extremely hot during and after operation. Care must be taken to avoid accidental burns.
- This appliance must be operated away from any flammable material or surfaces and materials.
- Never leave the torch unattended once lit. Extinguish the torch first ensuring it is completely out and safe before leaving unattended.
- Protect from direct sunlight. Do not expose to temperature above 50°C/120°F.
- Do not breathe gas, fumes, vapour or spray. If inhaled, move the person to a fresh air environment.
- For maximum protection, always wear safety goggles, gloves or other appropriate equipment.
- Avoid contact with eyes or skin. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice.
